Dear Parents,

I hope you all had a wonderful Christmas and were able to enjoy the holiday. I am writing to inform you that **school will resume on January 4th, and we will be back to in-person instruction.** As a reminder, students must wear masks/face coverings during the school day, adhere to social distancing guidelines, wash their hands often, and stay home if they are ill. Parents are to conduct health self-checks prior to students boarding the school bus each day. Any questions should be directed to Poppy York, the SAD #42 school nurse.

Because of the abatement project at Fort Street, the 1:30 and 2:30 dismissal procedure will change. Beginning on Monday, parents who plan to pick up their child(ren) at Fort Street must do so at **1:15 pm** instead of 1:30 pm. Pick up time at the end of the school day **will remain at 2:30 pm.** This change will remain in effect until the abatement and rug replacement project are completed.
